

Discipline Support Module Administration – Marathon Racing

This document outlines the administration requirements for course organisers running the British Canoeing Marathon Racing Discipline Support Module:

- Course Authorisation is required by Directors prior to running the module; this is obtained through the National Association Delivery Centre Coaching Office and must be requested at least 14-days in advance of the course.
- Candidates must register for the module with their National Association prior to attending the course. Candidates register via the National Association Membership Portal. The registration process checks that candidates have the necessary prerequisites.
- At the point of registration, the following prerequisites are required:
 - Registration Fee for National Association Members;
 - A British Canoeing Coaching Qualification;
 - Aged 16 years of age, or older.
- It is important that Directors check that candidates hold the necessary prerequisites. These will be checked by the National Association and only candidates who have registered will be acknowledged by the National Association as completing the training.
- End of Course: The Director should upload the course results to the National Association Membership Portal within 7 days of the end of the course.
- After completing the module, candidates receive a certificate confirming attendance.

- Directors must be registered with their National Association Delivery Centre as a recognised British Canoeing Marathon Racing Discipline Support Module Director.
- The Ratio for the Discipline Support Modules is 1 registered Director, with a
 minimum of 4, and maximum of 12 candidates (if working with more than 8,
 technical support is required from a discipline specialist). Directors must seek
 permission from their National Association if they wish to run courses outside
 these ratios.
- Applications for new Directors are processed through British Canoeing.
 Applicants who meet the following requirements will be considered:
 - Current British Canoeing Performance (or equivalent qualification/experience);
 - Recent experience of educating Coaches (Coaches without tutoring experience are able to progress as a second member of staff);
 - Varied discipline coaching experience, including 6 session progressions;
 - Thorough understanding of tactical, technical, physical and psychological requirements of beginner marathon paddlers.

New Directors are required to complete British Canoeing Orientation prior to delivery.
