

Canoeing Ireland Equivalence Document

This document provides guidance on equivalence of awards for employers, clubs and coaches as well as the process for a qualified instructor of Canoe Ireland transferring to British Canoeing Awarding Body Coaching awards and delivering Personal Performance Awards.

Equivalence between Canoe Ireland Instructor qualifications and British Canoeing Awarding Body Coaching awards **only** exist for the qualifications listed below.

Canoeing Ireland Instructors can become providers of the Personal Performance Awards. To ensure continuity in the delivery of British Canoeing Awarding Body awards, Canoe Ireland Instructors will need to provide the evidence outlined below. This recognition will also allow Canoe Ireland Instructors to operate on a voluntary or commercial basis with their Canoe Ireland Instructor Awards across British Canoeing Awarding Body Delivery Centres.

- National membership
- Copy of CI Instructor Certificate
- Copy of a valid First Aid certificate
- Evidence of Child Protection Training
- Evidence of CPD over the past 3 years

Canoe Ireland Instructors will need to request to become a provider of Personal Performance Awards with their Delivery Centre.

Canoe Ireland Instructors wanting to transfer into the British Canoeing Awarding Body scheme will need to complete an Accredited Prior Learning application with their Delivery Centre evidencing their current experience and level of skill and understanding. A successful assessment will need to be conducted before certification is issued.
